We, fanciers of poultry and pigeons hailing from the tiny Mediterranean country of Malta, invite you to take a stroll with us through one of Malta's oldest and most beautiful gardens, the gardens of San Anton Palace, where in the beginning of May 2014 the annual Fur and Feather Show was traditionally held, filling the luscious and elegant gardens with the clucking, crowing, quacking and cooing of well over half a thousand poultry and pigeons.

The Fur and Feather Show in the Maltese Islands dates back to 1920-ies, a tradition started by the British governor as Malta was a British colony in those times. Poultry, pigeon, bird and rabbit enthusiasts were then gathered in one large club. Malta Fancy Poultry and Pigeon Club was formed 35 years ago of poultry, pigeon and fowl fanciers. For the last 5 years two clubs - that of rabbit fanciers and our Malta Fancy Poultry and Pigeon Club - organize this show as a joint venture, which makes it a spectacular sight indeed and the Club's largest event of the year.



The graceful pathways of the gardens are lined with rows of exhibition cages, some of them encircling a large pond where the garden's own waterfowl live; large birds such as peacocks, turkeys and geese are placed in larger cages for comfort, and pigeons and doves are found in their own separate section.

The weather in Malta in the late spring can usually be counted on, but this year was a small exception with some Saturday morning rain on however caused no which harm because the birds had been covered to protect them from the elements. The clouds lifted and the day continued to unfold beautifully as the judging commenced. A little later Honorary Secretary for Animal Rights in Malta, Mr.

Roderick Galdes, made an appearance and officially opened the show. Meanwhile peacock Troy of the young Club member and peafowl enthusiast Bernardette Cutajar greeted everyone at the entrance to the park throughout the day, making him arguably the most photographed bird of the weekend!

With the country's whole population being approximately 1/3 of that of Amsterdam or less than 1/7 of Berlin, that seems to be enough entries to begin to admire and appreciate the enthusiasm of the Maltese poultry and pigeon keepers!

The birds were evaluated by several judges. Pigeons were judged by Raymond Ebejer, Jason Buttigieg and Raymond Debattista, fowl by Kevin Mallia and Nenu Saliba, and chickens by Reg Massey (UK) who himself is a breeder of Araucana, Booted Bantam, Barbu d'Anvers, Dorking and Polish chickens. The show was generously sponsored by our supporters: one of the largest pet supply distributors in the Maltese Islands "Borg Cardona & Co.Ltd", as well as by Andrews Feeds, "Tas-Salib" Veterinary Pharmacy, KPH Feeds and Malta Dairy Products.



The majority of entries were chickens - this year saw some 350 chickens, 200 pigeons and around 50 specimens of other types of fowl (waterfowl, pheasants, turkeys, quail, doves).
